APPLIED BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIP

Terms of Reference

A partnership between Nelson Marlborough Institute of Technology and Arrow International Limited has resulted in the above scholarship to be awarded for the support and development of learners at the Institute and their progress towards the world of work.

Area of Use:

Students enrolled on Year 1 of the NMIT Bachelor of Commerce – majoring in Management, Marketing and Accounting (3 years).

This scholarship is designed to assist the student with the tutorial component of fees up to \$2,000 per year to a maximum of 3 years.

Eligibility:

Students must be enrolled and accepted on the above programmes and intending to study at NMIT, Nelson campus fulltime.

Applicants must be a New Zealand citizen or hold a New Zealand permanent residency permit.

Should the recipient not complete the year of study that the scholarship has been awarded, it is at the discretion of NMIT and/or Arrow International Limited whether all or part of the scholarship received be returned to NMIT.

Should the student withdraw or not pass any part of their programme the scholarship will not be paid for further study.

Selection Criteria: Recipient of this scholarship will show strong leadership qualities and have well rounded academic ability.

Exclusions:

This Scholarship cannot be taken in conjunction with any other NMIT scholarship.

Value:

One Scholarship of up to \$2,000 annually, towards tutorial fee component credited directly onto the student fees or to studylink if a debt exists. To a maximum of three years at the discretion of the selection panel.



Panel Selection:

A panel made up of Programme area Leader of the Business School, Representative from Arrow International and Director of Planning, Quality and Learner Services or representatives.

Decisions of the Panel are not open to appeal.

Promotion: Application forms and information will be circulated via student enrolments and in NMIT scholarship advertising and print publications and will be available on the NMIT website.

All scholarship recipients must agree to be available for publicity and promotional purposes by NMIT and Arrow International Limited.

Timing: Applications must be received on an official application form to NMIT by 2.00 pm on 22 February 2012. Late applications will not be accepted. The scholarship will be announced early in the academic year and awarded at a function shortly thereafter. Attendance at the scholarship function is required to receive this scholarship.

Validation: The award of a Scholarship shall become void within 2 weeks after receiving official advice unless the recipient completes and forwards the Acceptance and Agreement Contract to NMIT Scholarship Coordinator that clarifies the Recipients acceptance of the Scholarship and agreement to perform any obligations, as stated in the Terms of Reference associated with this Scholarship.

Privacy:

The award of the scholarship may be acknowledged in media and marketing material by both NMIT and Arrow International Limited.

In accordance with the Privacy Act 1993, recipients will sign a Release Form giving their permission for NMIT to use recipient's personal information for publicity. The recipient can control the content used and length of time it is used.
