

Equity Scholarship for Woman

Terms of Reference

Aim: To support female students studying at Nelson Marlborough Institute of Technology. Priority should be given to students who are not entitled to Student Allowance or Training Incentive Allowance.

Area of Use: Wish to enrol at Nelson Marlborough Institute of Technology in 2012 to start or continue a course leading to a recognised qualification.

Eligibility: Students who identify themselves upon enrolment as being female. Students must be enrolled on a full time programme and have met specific programme entry requirements.

Exclusions: This Scholarship may not be used in conjunction with the Half Degree for Free Scholarship. This Scholarship is not available for NMIT short courses or Employment Scholarship Programmes (unless stipulated). Only one NMIT Scholarship can be awarded to a student in any one Calendar Year.

Value and Funding: Maximum allocation of \$500. This scholarship is funded by NMIT and payment will be by means of rebate on fees or to studylink if a debt exists.

Promotion: Application forms and information will be circulated via student enrolments, and advertised via posters and on the NMIT website.

Students receiving a Hardship grant/scholarship have the option to not participate in any NMIT promotions.

Criteria

- Are a female and a New Zealand resident
- Exhibit high motivation and the ability to succeed
- Demonstrate the need for financial assistance that may prevent their ability to succeed

Panel: The Panel will be made up of One Group Manager or representative and two NMIT staff members

Selection will be made at a time that allows the grant/scholarship to be awarded early in the academic year.

Panel Decision: Decisions of the Panel are not open to appeal or question. The Panel need not give reasons for any of their decisions.

Timing: Applications must be received on an official application form to NMIT by 2.00 pm on 22 February 2012. Late applications will not be accepted.

Validation: The award of a Scholarship shall become void within 2 weeks after receiving official advice unless the recipient completes and forwards the Acceptance and Agreement Contract to NMIT Scholarship Coordinator that states:

- The Recipients acceptance of the Scholarship and agreement to perform any obligations, as stated in the Terms of Reference. Associated with this Scholarship
- Agreement to participate in specified promotion as per Terms of Reference
- The Recipients intention of pursuing the course of intended study set out in his/her application.

Payment: Payment will be made as a rebate of fees.

Studylink Notes: Permanent residents and Australian citizens will now be subject to a two year stand down before they can access student loans via Studylink. For more information please contact www.studylink.govt.nz .
