



Blenheim Lions Scholarship

Value: One \$1,500 scholarship

Application due date: 5.00pm, 31 March

Aim of the Scholarship

To support students who show the potential to excel in their chosen field of study at NMIT, Marlborough Campus.

Selection criteria

- Be enrolled full time or part time on a programme of at least one year's duration leading to a recognised qualification at NMIT's Marlborough campus.
- You'll need to demonstrate evidence of academic excellence and display a passion and ability to succeed in your chosen field.

What do you receive?

- This scholarship is designed to assist you with course fees and is a one off payment to the maximum value of \$1,500.

What do you need to commit to?

- Attending the scholarship presentation ceremony
- Writing to the Blenheim Lions and informing them of your progress during the year.
- Agreeing to be available for promotional purposes by NMIT/Blenheim Lions

Terms & conditions

1. The scholarship may not be awarded in any given year if the calibre of the applicants does not meet the required standards, even if this decision is made after the application date for the scholarships has passed.
2. The scholarship does not cover student association fees, re-sit costs, or text books and any other course materials.
3. If you do not complete the course requirements, the scholarship may need to be refunded. This will be at the discretion of Blenheim Lions and NMIT.
4. This scholarship cannot be taken in conjunction with any other NMIT scholarship.
5. This Scholarship is not available for NMIT short courses, Employment Scholarship Programme (unless stipulated).
6. The decision about awarding the scholarships will be made by a panel which includes NMIT Marlborough Campus Manager and a member of the Blenheim Lions Board. Decisions of the Panel are final and are not open to appeal.
7. Applications must be forwarded on an official online application form and received by NMIT by 5.00 pm on 31 March. Late applications will not be accepted. The scholarships

will be announced early in the academic year and awarded at a function shortly thereafter. You must attend the ceremony or the scholarship may be withdrawn.

8. The award of a scholarship shall become void within two weeks after receiving official advice unless you complete and forward the Acceptance and Agreement Contract to NMIT Scholarship Coordinator that clarifies your acceptance of the scholarship and agreement to perform any obligations, as stated in the Terms of Reference associated with this scholarship.
9. If a debt exists to Studylink or NMIT it will be paid to these accounts. If no debt exists it will be paid into your nominated bank account.
10. The award of the scholarship may be acknowledged in media and marketing material by both NMIT and Blenheim Lions.
11. In accordance with the Privacy Act 1993, you will need to sign a Release Form giving your permission for NMIT and Blenheim Lions to use your personal information for publicity in relation to the scholarship. You can control the content and length of time it is used.
