



NELSON PINE SCHOLARSHIP

Business Scholarship

Terms of Reference 2018 onwards

Area of Use:	Any Business programme at either Level 6, 7 or 8.
Value:	\$1000 paid as a tuition fees rebate directly onto course fees or Studylink if a debt exists.
Eligibility:	Study must be fulltime and the applicant must have already been studying at NMIT in the year prior to the scholarship. The student must be a New Zealand citizen or hold a NZ residency permit.
Criteria:	The student must demonstrate achievement at Level 5 or above and be progressing to Level 6 or above and show potential to excel in the field of Marketing, Management or Accounting. NMIT academic record will be taken into consideration.
Exclusions:	Only one NMIT Scholarship can be awarded to a student in any one Calendar Year.
Funding:	Funded by Nelson Pine Industries Limited and awarded by their representative at the scholarship ceremony early in the academic year. Attendance at the ceremony is required to receive the scholarship.
Promotion:	Application forms and information will be available on NMIT website at www.nmit.ac.nz
Selection:	A panel made up of NMIT staff will consider each application and assist in making the selection.
Panel Decision:	Decisions of the Panel are not open to appeal or question. The Panel need not give reasons for any of their decisions.
Timing:	Applications must be received on the official online application form from nmit.ac.nz by 5 pm on 20 February 2020 . Late applications will not be accepted.

Validation:

The award of a Scholarship shall become void within 2 weeks after receiving official advice unless the recipient completes and forwards the Acceptance and Agreement Contract to NMIT Scholarship Coordinator that states:

- The Recipients acceptance of the Scholarship and agreement to perform any obligations, as stated in the Terms of Reference associated with this Scholarship.
- Agreement to participate in specified promotion as per Terms of Reference.
- The Recipients intention of pursuing the course of intended study set out in his/her application.
- Recipient must be present at the Scholarship presentation event or the Scholarship will be withdrawn.

Privacy:

In accordance with the Privacy Act 1993, recipients will need to sign a Release Form giving their permission for NMIT and Nelson Pine Industries to use recipient's personal information for publicity. The recipient can control the content used and length of time it is used.
